



School Uniform Policy

Expectation

All girls are expected to wear school uniform every day, this means at school and when travelling to and from school. They are also expected to wear full uniform on all occasions and when representing the school or on school activities.

School Uniform Basics

- **Shirt:** A school shirt must be worn. The shirt can be a polo shirt or blouse and must have a collar and sleeves; it may have the school badge but no other markings. The shirt is a compulsory part of the uniform. Any shirt worn under the school shirt must be white.
 - **Juniors (Years 7 – 10):** White school shirt
 - **Seniors (Years 11 – 12):** Lemon school shirt
- **Skirt or trousers:** Trousers must be full length office style for the senior and junior students. The trousers are not to be made of knit, stretchy fabric. Jeans, tights/leggings or tracksuit style pants are not acceptable to wear as school trousers. The green check skirt is not to be made of stretch knit fabric and must at least reach the knee.
 - Year 12 students are permitted to wear the special Year 12 jersey, which they have designed in collaboration with their Year Adviser. However, the school shirt is still required to worn under the jersey.
- **Shoes:** should be black leather covered school shoes. For safety reasons they must be completely enclosed. *Open topped shoes, scuffs, sandals, or thongs are not permitted at any time.* Shoes should not have raised soles or heels that could lead to an injury.
- **Socks/Stockings:** socks must be white. Stockings can be black or flesh coloured.
- **Hats and Scarves:** Students are encouraged to wear sun hats when outdoors in the sun. The school has a green and yellow sun hat available at uniform suppliers. Head scarves are to be plain black in colour. Jelbabs are not part of the school uniform.

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- **School Tie:** is optional for students in all years. If worn, the tie is to be used on the white or lemon school shirt (not the sports uniform) and should be neatly tied and in place.
- **School Blazer:** the School blazer is optional. It can be worn daily and is available from the uniform suppliers.
- **Jewellery:** should be conservative and not hazardous. This means that large earrings, large rings on fingers, lip and eyebrow studs and rings, are not permitted.



Sports Uniform

The sports uniform consists of a yellow and green sports shirt, bottle green shorts or tracksuit pants with appropriate shoes. Students are expected to change for all PE classes OR the sports uniform may be worn on the day a student has sport and/or when representing the school in sporting activities.

Sport Days: The full school sport uniform may be worn to and from school only on the days the student has sport. On these days, students either wear the full school uniform or full sport uniform – NOT a mixture.

Note: Senior students who do not study SLR are not permitted to wear sports uniform as an alternate uniform

OUT OF UNIFORM: If for any reason a student is unable to wear school uniform she is expected to see her roll call teacher for a uniform pass during roll call time. Students are expected to bring a note signed by her parent explaining why they are out of uniform. Repeated failure to wear the correct uniform may result in parent interviews, warnings of suspension and/or suspension for persistent disobedience.

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FOOTWEAR SAFETY

The School Uniform Policy states that students must wear black leather closed in shoes. The shoes are to protect students during practical activities where they use hot oil, food, chemicals and other sharp and heavy equipment.

The Chemical Safety Act requires students to wear “covered leather shoes” in Science labs, TAS classrooms and Art classrooms.



Several high schools have recently been inspected by Workcover and served notices that the ballet shoes or Mary Jane shoes worn by many female students do not meet the requirements of a “covered shoe”. Principals have been instructed that students must meet the requirements of the WH&S and Chemical Safety Act.



Students are NOT to wear the ballet type shoe or joggers. The top of the foot must be covered by the shoe. If purchasing shoes in the coming months please ensure covered shoes are purchased.
